Terms and Conditions for trading on Hyndburn's Markets

1. All casual traders are required to complete an enrolment form prior to trading.
2. New traders are required to provide some form of identification which confirms both their name and address prior to trading. Suitable forms of identification include the following:- driving licence, utility invoices or other formal document confirming name and address.
3. Unless prior agreement has been obtained, stalls must be occupied by 9.00am at the latest. If you anticipate being late, please telephone the market office.
4. Casual traders are required to pay stall fees prior to occupying a stall.
5. Only cheques accompanied by a current cheque guarantee card will be accepted from casual traders.
6. Building out fees are charged in addition to the basic stall fee but building out is not permitted in all areas. Please ask at the Market Office.
7. Traders are required to remain in occupation of their respective stalls until the market's closing time.
8. All vehicles should be removed from the market by 9.00am at the latest – please note that the south service yard is for loading/unloading only. The maximum permitted time for vehicles in the south service yard is 45 minutes – **PLEASE BEWARE – OFFENDING VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO PENALTIES, SEE NOTICES IN YARD.** Casual traders should display their stall receipt on their dashboard, penalty notices issued due to failure to display a valid permit or receipt will not be cancelled.
9. **WASTE DISPOSAL** Please ensure that your stall or pitch is clean and tidy before you leave the market. If you do have waste that requires disposing of, please take it away with you, put it in the bins provided, or place it in a plastic bag and leave it at the side of your stall, all cardboard boxes should be flattened. Please note that we are unable to dispose of any unsold stock, wooden pallets, items of furniture or any electrical appliances.
10. We have no specific car park facilities, but all car parks in Accrington are free.
11. Power sockets are provided on most stalls. No additional charge is made for this facility, however the operator will not guarantee that this facility is available at all times and will not refund any charges if the sockets do not work.
