

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## UK Parliamentary election For the Hyndburn constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Hyndburn.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Acting Returning Officer, Hyndburn Borough Council, Scaitcliffe House, Ormerod Street, Accrington, BB5 0PF.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at Hyndburn Borough Council, Scaitcliffe House, Ormerod Street, Accrington, BB5 0PF on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Thursday 14 November 2019.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on 12 December 2019.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019. Applications can be made on line [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote).
6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal vote or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hyndburn Borough Council, Scaitcliffe House, Ormerod Street, Accrington, BB5 0PF by 5 p.m. on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hyndburn Borough Council, Scaitcliffe House, Ormerod Street, Accrington, BB5 0PF by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hyndburn Borough Council, Scaitcliffe House, Ormerod Street, BB5 0PF by 5 p.m. on 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
