

Email from Programme Officer to Representors 030625

Representors

Further to my original communication of 26 April I am now able to let you have an update on key events relating to the Hyndburn local plan. As before, I will add this latest news to the Examination webpage [Hyndburn Local Plan to 2040 Examination – Hyndburn Borough Council](#) and this will continue to be a reference point for keeping interested parties aware of progress with the Examination.

Next stages are expected to include the following:

1. The Council recently responded to the Inspector's Initial Questions – the Council have undertaken to respond on a small number of outstanding points by the end of June and these should be available via the webpage above shortly thereafter.
2. The Inspector's comprehensive Matters Issues and Questions are expected to be issued in July and I will provide these directly to you with additional guidance notes, including the opportunity to make further comments if you wish to enlarge upon your original representations. Please do not submit any new material in the meantime.
3. Provisional dates for public hearings to be held locally are as follows:
Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 16-18 September
Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 23-25 September
Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 7-9 October
Fridays of the respective weeks above have been allocated as reserve days in case any topics significantly overrun.

A more detailed timetable will be available in due course, enabling you to identify which particular dates are relevant to your own areas of interest. Attendees may simply observe proceedings, or alternatively may address the Inspector directly – I will seek your intentions nearer the time.

I continue to be your first port of call for all administrative matters regarding the Examination and you are welcome to contact me at any stage.
