

Email 090925 from Programme Officer to Representors

This email is addressed to those who made representations at the two Regulation 19 consultations on the local plan which is now approaching public hearings.

You will have had my previous emails on this topic and in particular that of 25 July (item INSP005a on the Examination webpage below). There has been a modest change to timetable and I am attaching a note of the new arrangements for your information. The hearings at the Council office on Ormerod Street are open to observers and while you do not formally need to advise me of any intentions to attend it would nevertheless help my preparations if you let me have a brief note.
